This international conference is dedicated to the 215th birth anniversary of a famous geologist, mineralogist, ethnologist, Rector of the University of Chile in Santiago, an outstanding scientist, a member of the November 1830 Uprising, a spokesperson for Lithuania, Poland and France Ignacy Domeyko (1802-1889). I. Domeyko moved to Vilnius in 1816 and lived on the Pilies street. Being only fourteen years old I. Domeyko started studying at the Department of Mathematics and Physics of Vilnius University.
